



WATERCOLOUR: Materials List

Brushes

- * Raphael mop brushes (French) petit gris pur number 4-8 (or similar)
- * Large wash brush Hake or Squirrelon for putting on large washes
- * Large round brush 'Sable' or Art Basics #6 wash brush
- * Medium round Sable or squirrel (Not nylon/synthetic)
- * Small round Sable or squirrel (Not nylon/synthetic)
- * Medium flat brush (Synthetic OK) * #4 Rigger (Synthetic OK)
- * A selection of permanent ink pens for pen and wash
- * Bring the brushes you have and we will discuss them during the class.

Paper

- * 300 gsm Arches or Saunders Waterford medium - rough/ cold pressed
- * A3 Cartridge Sketching Pad

Other

- * Photos or reference material * 2B + 4B soft pencil * Putty eraser
- * Soft white eraser * Large watercolour palette * Masking fluid
- * Water containers x 2 * Tissues and/or Paper towels * Old hand towel and rags
- * Fine Mister Water Bottle * UV Sun protection * Insect repellent
- * Suitable backing "Support Board" for positioning paper on to paint against
- * Suitable Easel (French Easel or similar) to hold suggested "Support Board"
- * Clothing - Comfortable & suitable for painting outdoors - Long sleeve shirt - Hat
- * Several (At least 4) Bulldog or Fold Back Clips (50 - 75 mm wide)
- * Gummed Brown Tape for securing paper to board * 25mm Roll Masking Tape
- * Small table or support for your art materials * Portable stool or chair
- * Carry caddy for all materials * Maybe sun shade or non-coloured umbrella
- * A plastic bag is a good idea to put scraps in * 3 meter Tape Measure

* This is a basic list of materials and students are welcome to bring their own appropriate materials from home, then as the workshops progresses, students can add to their colours and range of materials if they feel the need.

- * Raw Sienna * Burnt Sienna * Burnt Umber * Raw Umber
- * Lemon Yellow * Turner's Yellow * Indian Yellow
- * Gold Ochre or Australian Red Gold
- * Winsor Orange or Cadmium orange
- * Cobalt Blue * Ultramarine Blue
- * Prussian Blue or Thalo Blue
- * Scarlet Lake * Alizarin Crimson
- * Opera
- * Sap Green * Viridian
- * Phthalo Green
- * Ultramarine Violet * Indigo * Sepia
- * Opaque White - Designers Gouache (Permanent White)
